We would like to thank Mrs H-T for coaching us, Mrs Blake for supporting us, the community bus for driving us.







My favourite Julia Donaldson book is The Highway Rat because the Highway Rat gets so fat! It really made me laugh and it will make you laugh too!


It is about a mean rat that steals everybody's food. How cruel he is! He gets tricked into a cave by a clever duck and all the animals get their food back!


Year 2 post-SATs picnic



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Year 6 – Mayfield Retreat




